

**A RESOLUTION  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE  
CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS  
TO THE PUBLIC ART COMMISSION**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 6-11 established the Public Art Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.1 of the City of Cherry Hills Village City Charter authorizes the City Council to "delegate to board and commissions...such functions, powers and authority of the City as it deems proper and advisable"; and

**WHEREAS**, Section III of the adopted Art in Public Places Master Plan states the Commission shall consist of up to five (5) members: including one (1) from City Council. On the date of appointment, each member shall be a resident of the City of Cherry Hills Village. Each member shall be a resident of the City throughout his or her term of office; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2-8-30 of the City Municipal Code requires each member be appointed by the City Council. The initial term of each member shall be staggered, as outlined in section 8-1 of the City Charter, with subsequent appointments to all be (3) three years. The terms of office shall expire on the third Tuesday of July in each respective year; and

**WHEREAS**, applications to fill the vacancy on the Commission were reviewed and interviews were conducted; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to appoint Gay Warren, Douglas Smooke, and Teresa Harbaugh to the Public Art Commission.


