**A RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF THE
VACANT DISTRICT 5 CITY COUNCIL SEAT**

WHEREAS, effective on April 10, 2006, Michael J. Wozniak resigned his position as District 5 Councilmember; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.9 of the City of Cherry Hills Village City Charter requires that if a Councilman's office shall become vacant, the vacancy shall be filled by a majority vote of the membership of the entire Council within 30 days after such vacancy occurs for the full then unexpired term of the office which has become vacant; and

WHEREAS, applications to serve on the City Council were received by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council interviewed candidates on April 24, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has decided to appoint a Councilmember to District 5 from this same pool of candidates.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE:
