Receiving Your Mail Ballot at Home

- Ballots will be mailed to voters beginning Monday, June 8.
- Update your registration by Monday, June 22 to have a ballot mailed to your home.
- Check that your address is current by going to [GoVoteColorado.gov](https://www.govotecolorado.gov) and selecting “Find registration.” New voters can select “Register to vote.”

In-person Appointments

- Most weekdays through Friday, June 26, residents can make an appointment to come to the Arapahoe County Administration Building at 5334 S. Prince St. for the full range of voter services.
- Go to the [appointments link](#) on [Arapahoevotes.com](https://www.arapahoevotes.com) (at the top of the page in the COVID-19 announcement) and select Voter Services from the first dropdown menu to book your appointment.

Curbside Pickup Service*

- Starting Monday, June 22, voters can order a replacement mail ballot for curbside pickup. Call 303-795-4511 that week, Monday – Friday 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., through Election Day, June 30.
- You can choose the day, time, and location to pick up your ballot in special parking spots at each of our six Voter Service and Polling Centers.

Returning Your Mail Ballot

- Don't forget to **sign your envelope**.
- Bring your voted ballot to any of our 24-hour drop boxes no later than 7 p.m. on Tuesday, June 30. No postage needed when you use a 24-hour drop box.
- Find the drop box closest to you by entering an address on our [Find My Nearest](#) webpage on [Arapahoevotes.com](https://www.arapahoevotes.com).
- A *new* 24-hr drop box is available at the Central Recreation Center, 18150 East Vassar Place, Aurora.
- Add postage and return your ballot from your home mailbox no later than Wednesday, June 24 to make sure we receive it by 7 p.m. on Election Day. Postmarks do not count.

Early Voting and In-person Voting*

- Avoid crowds and use our eight days of early voting, starting 9 a.m. on Monday, June 22. This includes Saturday, June 27 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- Locations, dates, and hours of our Voter Service and Polling Centers are on [Arapahoevotes.com](https://www.arapahoevotes.com).
- On Election Day, Tuesday, June 30—weather permitting—some Voter Service Centers will have staffed tents outside providing express voter services, allowing for additional social distancing.
- If voting in person, please follow posted public health safety guidelines and instructions to protect yourself, our election judges, and fellow voters.
