**A RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
CONCERNING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF AN ALTERNATE MEMBER
TO THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND APPEALS**

WHEREAS, Section 8.2 of the City of Cherry Hills Village City Charter requires that members of the Board of Adjustment and Appeals (BOAA) be appointed by the Council for overlapping terms of three years; be a taxpaying elector, and have resided in the area comprising the City at the time of appointment for at least three years immediately preceding the date of appointment; and

WHEREAS, Section 16-7-30(c) of the City of Cherry Hills Village Municipal Code states that "The City Council may from time to time appoint a member of the City Council to serve as a member of the Board"; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 10, Series 2019 appointed Councilor Randy Weil to serve as an alternate member of the BOAA for a term ending at the first City Council meeting 2021; and

WHEREAS, Councilor Weil desires to continue to serve in this role; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to reappoint Councilor Randy Weil to serve as the alternate member of the BOAA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE THAT:
