ACCEPTING AN ANONYMOUS DONATION FROM A RESIDENT ON BEHALF OF THE  
CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Cherry Hills Village Police Department received an unanticipated and generous donation from an anonymous resident to be used by the Police Department in the amount of \$15,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 13.7, titled *Bequests, Gifts and Donations*, of the Cherry Hills Village Home Rule Charter, authorizes the City Council to receive bequests, gifts and donations of all kinds of property for public, charitable or other purposes and to do all things and acts necessary to carry out the purposes of such bequests, gifts and donations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department desires to utilize the proceeds of the donation for future equipment needs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado that:


**Section 1.** The City Council hereby accepts a cash donation in the amount of \$15,000.00 from an anonymous donor to be used by the Cherry Hills Village Police Department to purchase police equipment and training needs as determined necessary or desirable by the Police Chief.

**Section 2.** The City Council directs City staff, including the Police Chief, Finance Director and City Manager, to take all steps necessary to effectuate the donation and to carry out the purpose of such donation.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
