RESOLUTION  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE  
AUTHORIZING THE 75<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY COMMITTEE TO ACCEPT  
DONATIONS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE

**WHEREAS**, City Council established the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee ("Committee") via Resolution 35-19, which resolution authorized the Committee to make recommendations to the City Council for events and activities to celebrate the City's 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary; and

**WHEREAS**, the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee recommends that it be authorized to accept donations on behalf of the City to help offset costs for all 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary-related events; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 13.7, titled *Bequests, Gifts and Donations*, of the Cherry Hills Village Home Rule Charter authorizes the City Council to receive bequests, gifts and donations of all kinds of property for public, charitable or other purposes and to do all things and acts necessary to carry out the purposes of such bequests, gifts and donations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to authorize the Committee to accept donations for the limited purpose of reducing or offsetting costs for events celebrating the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the incorporation of Cherry Hills Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado that:


**Section 1.** The City Council hereby authorizes the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee to accept donations on behalf of the City of Cherry Hills Village for the limited purpose of reducing or offsetting costs for events celebrating the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the incorporation of Cherry Hills Village. This authority shall expire contemporaneously with the dissolution of the Committee.

**Section 2.** The City Council directs City staff, including the Finance Director and City Manager, to take all steps necessary to effectuate the donations and to carry out the purpose of such donations.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.


