

A RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
APPOINTING A NEW MEMBER TO THE CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE ART COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Section 3.1 of the City of Cherry Hills Village City Charter authorizes the City Council to “delegate to board and commissions...such functions, powers and authority of the City as it deems proper and advisable”; and

WHEREAS, the Cherry Hills Village Art Commission (the “Commission”) was established by Resolution 6, Series 2011 and expanded by Resolution 10, Series 2017; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Sarah Anderson resigned from the Commission before the end of her term; and

WHEREAS, applications were solicited in the Village Crier and through the City website; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Pro Tem Randy Weil and Councilor Robert Eber reviewed the application and conducted the interview; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Pro Tem Randy Weil and Councilor Robert Eber recommend appointment of Benjamin Ortiz-Hill to complete the vacant term on the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to appoint Mr. Ortiz-Hill to complete the vacant term on the Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE THAT:


