RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
APPROVING A SOFTWARE AS A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH TYLER TECHNOLOGIES,
INC. FOR MUNICIPAL COURT SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, pursuant to its general municipal powers and C.R.S. § 31-15-101, the City of Cherry Hills Village ("City") is authorized to enter into contracts for the performance of general municipal governance and services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village's Purchasing Policy requires City Council approval for non-budgeted transactions over \$10,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration Department desires to make a purchase in excess of \$10,000.00 that was not included in the approved 2024 budget to implement replacement software for municipal court case management; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into a software as a service agreement with Tyler Technologies, Inc., a Delaware corporation, for the use of its municipal court case management software (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to approve the Agreement and further desires to authorize the Mayor to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City once in final form.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado that:

Section 1. The City Council hereby: (a) approves the Agreement in substantially the same form as attached hereto as **Attachment A**; (b) authorizes the City Attorney, in consultation with the Director of Finance and Administration and the City Manager, to negotiate appropriate changes to the Agreement that do not materially increase the City's obligations; and (c) authorizes the Mayor to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City once in final form.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.


