RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
APPROVING AND RATIFYING CHANGE ORDERS TO THE CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT
WITH HALCYON CONSTRUCTION, INC. CONCERNING THE QUINCY FARM HISTORIC
BARN REHABILITATION**

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village (“City”) and Halcyon Construction, Inc., a Colorado corporation (“Contractor”), entered into a Construction Agreement in September 2024 (“Agreement”) for the Quincy Farm historic barn rehabilitation (“Project”) in the amount of \$718,408.00; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with approving the Agreement, City Council approved a five percent contingency of \$35,920.00, for a total authorized maximum expenditure of \$754,328.00 on the Project; and

WHEREAS, as noted in the staff report, conditions in the barn and existing utilities have necessitated additional work for the Project, some anticipated and some unanticipated; and

WHEREAS, Change Order 13, a copy of which is attached to this resolution as **Exhibit 1**, administratively extended the Contract Time from 160 working days to 220 working days from the date of the Notice to Proceed for a new deadline of July 28, 2025 to complete the Project, and City staff recommends that City Council ratify Change Order 13 to comply with the Agreement as written; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate the completion of necessary work on the Project that was unknown at the time of the Agreement and that became apparent after Change Orders 1-3 were approved in October 2024, City staff recommends approval of Change Order 18, a copy of which is attached to this resolution as **Exhibit 2**, to increase the Contract Sum in the amount of \$49,131.11, for a new not-to-exceed Contract Sum in the amount of \$878,891.11; and

WHEREAS, the City has appropriated sufficient funds to support expenditures within the proposed adjusted Contract Sum; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to ratify Change Order 13, approve Change Order 18 to bring the revised total not-to-exceed Contract Sum to \$878,891.11, and authorize the Mayor to execute Change Order 18 on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals and findings are incorporated into this resolution as findings and conclusions of the City Council.

Section 2. The City Council hereby: (1) ratifies Change Order 13 as set forth in **Exhibit 1**; (2) approves Change Order 18 in substantially the same form as is attached in **Exhibit 2**; and (3) authorizes the Mayor to execute Change Order 18 on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. Repealer. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are repealed.

Miscellaneous carpentry

- Materials Only (All labor associated with these repairs is in the added General Conditions below. This removed any double charges as these added items were performed by Halcyon):

○ East stall wall and 2x8 door bump out	\$160.00
○ Baseboard	\$310.00
○ Aluminum weather barrier on the south side	\$75.00
○ Casement window, weather enclosure and hardware	\$228.00
○ Additional door hardware	\$69.00

Material Subtotal: \$842.00

- Extended General Conditions (\$829/day and duration from 3/4/25 to 6/26/25 = 75 working days excluding weekends and holidays) This rate is discounted as the original bid included \$1,045.80/day for General Conditions. Four days were added to cover the last few change orders for the cabinet install, backflow, and heater.
 - This added time takes into consideration that Halcyon caused a 3 week delay with concrete that tested under specifications.
 - $\$829 \times 64 \text{ days} = \$53,056.00$
- Markup (8%) $\$ 4,311.84$
