

**ORDINANCE NO. 05
Series 2008**

February 19, 2008: Introduced as Council Bill 2, Series 2008 by Councilmember Doug Tisdale, seconded by Councilmember Russell Stewart, and considered by the title only on first reading. Passed by a vote of 6 yes and 0 no.

March 4, 2008: Considered in full text on second reading. Passed by a vote of 6 yes and 0 no.

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE,
AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008**

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village owns and operates the sanitary sewer infrastructure and facilities in the former Cherry Ridge, Cherrymoor, and Cherry Hills Rancho Sanitation Districts; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide safe and efficient sanitary waste disposal to the residents served by these sanitary districts; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village intends to provide these services in the best interest of the residents; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, must evaluate the integrity of the system as well as have accurate records as to the location of all of the sanitary sewer infrastructure and facilities which it owns and operates; and

WHEREAS, the bids received for this evaluation were higher than amounts previously appropriated for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the 2008 Budget and Appropriations be hereby supplemented by increasing the following funds and accounts, to-wit:


Water and Sewer Fund 20
