RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
ACCEPTING A GENEROUS DONATION FROM DANIEL TULLY AND DIANNE TULLY ON
BEHALF OF THE CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Cherry Hills Village Police Department received an unanticipated and generous donation from residents Daniel and Dianne Tully to be used for police equipment in the amount of \$5000.00; and

WHEREAS, Section 13.7, titled *Bequests, Gifts and Donations*, of the Cherry Hills Village Home Rule Charter, authorizes the City Council to receive bequests, gifts and donations of all kinds of property for public, charitable or other purposes and to do all things and acts necessary to carry out the purposes of such bequests, gifts and donations; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department desires to utilize the proceeds of the donation to purchase equipment such as, less than lethal weapons and accessories, duty shotguns, Tazers, and flashlights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado that:

Section 1. The City Council hereby accepts a cash donation in the amount of \$5000.00 from Daniel Tully and Dianne Tully to be used by the Cherry Hills Village Police Department to purchase police equipment as determined necessary or desirable by the Police Chief.

Section 2. The City Council directs City staff, including the Police Chief, Finance Director and City Manager, to take all steps necessary to effectuate the donation and to carry out the purpose of such donation.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.


