**A RESOLUTION  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE  
AMENDING RESOLUTION 6, SERIES 2011  
CONCERNING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS  
ON THE PUBLIC ART COMMISSION**

**WHEREAS**, through Resolution 6, Series 2011, the City Council established the Public Art Commission ("the PAC") to advise the City Council on matters related to public art; and

**WHEREAS**, the PAC has recommended that Council increase the number of members on the PAC in order to distribute the work load in a more reasonable manner; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council desires that the membership of the PAC and the powers and duties of the Council liaison to the PAC be consistent with other City Boards and Commissions; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council desires to increase the number of voting members on the PAC from five to seven, and to make the City Council representative to the PAC a non-voting member.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE THAT:**

**Section 1.** Section 6 of Resolution 6, Series 2011 is hereby amended to read:

The PAC shall consist of up to five (5) seven (7) voting members, including and a non-voting City Council representative. All members are appointed by the City Council. Members must be residents of Cherry Hills Village. Outside expertise may be consulted as needed, subject to Section 4 above. The City Council will consider applicants for their knowledge, experience, interest and involvement in the arts in Cherry Hills Village.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately.

Introduced, passed and adopted at the regular meeting of City Council this 7<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2017, by a vote of 6 yes and 0 no.
