A RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
REAPPOINTING TERESA HARBAUGH
TO THE PUBLIC ART COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Section 3.1 of the City of Cherry Hills Village City Charter authorizes the City Council to "delegate to board and commissions...such functions, powers and authority of the City as it deems proper and advisable"; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 6-11 established the Public Art Commission; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 6-11 states the Commission shall consist of up to five (5) voting members, including a Council representative. All members are appointed by the City Council. Members must be residents of Cherry Hills Village; and

WHEREAS, the term of appointment of Commissioner Teresa Harbaugh will expire on the third Tuesday of July 2015; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Harbaugh has served one, three-year term on the Commission and is eligible for reappointment; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Harbaugh has expressed a desire to be reappointed for an additional term; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to reappoint Commissioner Harbaugh to a new term on the Public Art Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE THAT:





Introduced, passed and adopted at the regular meeting of City Council this 21st day of July, 2015, by a vote of 5 yes and 0 no.


