

A RESOLUTION  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE  
TO FACILITATE MORE EFFICIENT, EXPANDED AND RELIABLE  
WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS FROM, TO AND WITHIN THE CITY

WHEREAS the health, safety and welfare of persons within the City of Cherry Hills Village will be promoted by taking appropriate steps to facilitate adequate wireless communications in times of emergency and otherwise;

WHEREAS it is important for the City and this Council to encourage and facilitate the establishment of a reliable and effective network of wireless communication facilities within the City;

WHEREAS, this Council, working closely with representatives of various wireless communication service providers, approved Ordinance 8, Series 2007, thereby amending the City's regulations concerning wireless communication facilities, in order to facilitate more efficient, expanded and reliable wireless communication from, to and within the City, without compromising the aesthetic values of the community,

WHEREAS, this Council desires to work with land owners in the community as well as various wireless communication service providers to attempt to find suitable locations for wireless communication facilities in the City that do not compromise aesthetic values of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, STATE OF COLORADO:


Section 1. That the City Manager shall encourage churches, clubs and other appropriate institutions and property owners to incorporate wireless communication facilities into their sites, where appropriate, reasonable, and not a compromise of the aesthetic values of the community.

Section 2. That the City Manager provide a copy of this Resolution along with Ordinance 8, Series 2007, to all wireless communication service providers in the region. In addition, the City Manager shall provide reasonable assistance to the wireless communication service providers, as requested.


Section 3. That the City Manager report back to the City Council concerning his efforts on or before the first regularly scheduled meeting of January 2008.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately.


