RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
CONCERNING
THE REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT'S (RTD)
PROPOSED USE OF SOUTH HAPPY CANYON ROAD FOR BUS ROUTE 46

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village has a duty and responsibility to its citizens to protect the public safety and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village and its residents were not provided a reasonable opportunity to be heard concerning the proposed use of South Happy Canyon Road by the Regional Transportation District ("RTD") for Bus Route 46; and

WHEREAS, a significant portion of South Happy Canyon Road is located in and maintained by City of Cherry Hills Village; and

WHEREAS, South Happy Canyon Road has been the focus of travel calming efforts for many years by the City of Cherry Hills Village; and

WHEREAS, Bus Route 46 as presently configured and operating today undermines those traffic calming efforts and adversely affects the safety of residents of the City of Cherry Hills Village; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village and its residents desire an opportunity to evaluate the Bus Route 46 and its impact on traffic, and to express those concerns to RTD.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE:

Requests that RTD promptly, after providing direct, adequate and reasonable notice and opportunity to be heard to Cherry Hills Village and affected property owners, re-evaluate the routing, frequency, and location of stops for Bus Route 46.


This Resolution shall be effective immediately.

of November, 2006, by a vote of 5 yes and 0 no.


