**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE
 OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE,
 AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005**

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village excluded from the South Suburban Park and Recreation District effective January 1, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide recreational reimbursement to its residents for recreational programs, activities, classes and events from public recreation providers; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village intends to provide partial recreational reimbursement to its residents for recreation programs, activities, classes and events offered by municipal or special district recreation departments in the seven county Denver Metropolitan Area (Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas, Jefferson);

WHEREAS, the City Council, pursuant to Article IX of the City Charter desires to ratify and authorize a supplemental appropriation in the amount of these additional funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the 2005 Budget and Appropriations be hereby supplemented by increasing the following funds and accounts, to-wit:

Parks and Recreation Fund 30
 As determined on or before December 31, 2005

Recreation Reimbursement Program	0	\$125,000.00

Section 2. The City Council hereby ratifies all expenditures heretofore and hereafter made pursuant to this supplemental appropriation ordinance.
