February 18, 2003: Introduced as Council Bill 02, Series of 2003 by Doug Tisdale. Seconded by Bonnie Blum, and considered by the title only on first reading. Passed unanimously.

March 4, 2003: Considered in full text on second reading. Passed unanimously. Designated as Ordinance No. 02 Series 2003.

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE
CREATING A PARKS AND RECREATION FUND**

WHEREAS, the residents of the City of Cherry Hills Village currently receive parks and recreation services from the South Suburban Parks and Recreation District; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates the exclusion from the South Suburban Park and Recreation District; and

WHEREAS, the City is required by Article IX Section 9.9 of the Charter to create a special fund by ordinance to account for monies to be held or used for special purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City will account for the transactions pertaining to the Parks and Recreation Fund separately from the General Fund;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, ORDAINS:

Section 1. That a fund is created for the purpose of accounting for parks and recreation activities and shall be called Parks and Recreation Fund.


Section 2. Should any section, clause, sentence or part of this ordinance be adjudged by any court to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect, impair or invalidate the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

Section 3. The City Council declares that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
