April 18, 2000: Introduced as Council Bill No. 7 Series 2000 by Doug Tisdale, seconded by Viola Lahana and considered by title only on first reading. Passed unanimously.

May 30, 2000: Considered in full text on second reading. Passed unanimously. Designated as Ordinance No. 9, Series 2000.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO AMENDING
ORDINANCE 3, SERIES 2000 EXTENDING THE TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE
ACCEPTANCE OF EXPANDED USE APPLICATIONS TO SEPTEMBER 14, 2000**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village adopted Ordinance 3, Series 2000, placing a temporary moratorium on the acceptance of expanded use applications until May 31, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the City held an election of City Council members on April 4, 2000 and is desirous of extending the moratorium so the newly seated Council can fully consider any changes to the municipal code;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Acceptance of Expanded Use Applications. The temporary moratorium on acceptance by the City of applications for expanded use under Code Sections 6-5-1, 6-10-2 or any other Section is extended for a period to and through September 14, 2000.

Adopted as Ordinance No. 9, Series 2000, by the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado, the 30TH day of May, 2000.
