

## ORDINANCE 21

## SERIES 2000

November 21, 2000: Introduced as Council Bill No. 21, Series of 2000 by Doug Tisdale, seconded by Jan Steiert, and considered by the title only on first reading. Passed unanimously.

December 12, 2000: Considered in full text on second reading. Passed unanimously. Designated as Ordinance No. 21, Series 2000.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE AMENDING SECTION 5-1-1-1(I) OF THE CITY CODE FOR THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE PERTAINING TO ELEVATOR INSPECTION FEES.

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village cooperates with the Denver Regional Council of Government's (DRCOG) elevator inspection program to provide inspection services for elevators, dumbwaiters, escalators or moving walks; and

WHEREAS, DRCOG charges an inspection fee for this service; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village is responsible under the terms of the program to collect and pay DRCOG these fees; and

WHEREAS, DRCOG is raising the rates it charges for elevator inspections,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (I) of Section 5-1-1-1 of the City Code for the City of Cherry Hills Village is hereby amended to read as follows:

- I. Add a new Table 3-D to read as follows:

**Table 3-D Elevator Inspection Fees**

(e) Fees. A fee for each permit or Certificate of Inspection shall be paid to the City as follows:

1. New installations and/or major alterations to passenger or freight elevator, escalator, moving walk, dumbwaiter or private residence not included as part of a new residence permit:

One percent (1%) of the total valuation.

Installation fees include charges for the first year's annual inspection fee.

2. Annual Certificates of Inspection:

For Each Elevator	\$125.150
For Each Escalator or Moving Walk	\$50.150
For Each Dumbwaiter	\$50.150

SECTION 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance should be found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be in valid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions or applications of this ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid portion, provided that such remaining portions or applications of this ordinance are not determined by the court to be inoperable.

Adopted as Ordinance No. 21, Series 2000, by the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado, the 12th day of December, 2000.
