RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE UNIFORM ELECTION CODE OF 1992
FOR THE APRIL 2, 2002, REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of the City Charter provides that elections are governed by the Colorado municipal election laws as amended or modified and municipalities are generally governed by the Colorado Municipal Election Code of 1965, codified at C.R.S. §§ 31-10-101 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. §§ 31-10-102.7 and 1-1-102 both state that any municipality may provide by resolution that it will utilize the requirements and procedures of the Uniform Election Code of 1992, articles 1 to 13 of title 1, C.R.S., in lieu of the Colorado Municipal Election Code of 1965, with respect to any election; and

WHEREAS, mail ballot elections are governed by article 7.5 of Title 1, C.R.S., which is part of the Uniform Election Code of 1992; and


WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village desires to conduct its April 2, 2002, regular municipal election as a mail ballot election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE:

Section 1. Pursuant to C.R.S. §§ 31-10-102.7 and 1-1-102, the City hereby adopts the Uniform Election Code of 1992, C.R.S. §§ 1-1-101 *et seq.*, specifically including article 7.5 of Title 1, for the purpose of conducting its April 2, 2002, regular municipal election.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
