

A
RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION PURSUANT TO
CITY CHARTER SECTION 2.10 TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2001

WHEREAS, the City Charter for the City of Cherry Hills Village requires that any special election be called by resolution of the City Council not less than 30 days prior to the date of such special election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to conduct a special election on the same date as the general election of November 6, 2001, and to have such special election coordinated by the Clerk and Recorder for Arapahoe County with the general election; and

WHEREAS, for any election to be held on the date of a general election that will be coordinated by the county clerk and recorder, formal action must be undertaken to participate in the election and notice must be sent to the clerk and recorder not less than 100 days prior to the date of the election; and


WHEREAS, as of the date of this Resolution, the City Council has not determined the questions or issues to be placed on the ballot for the special election but expects that one or more matters may be approved for submission to the registered electors,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE:

Section 1. Pursuant to City Charter Section 2.10, the City Council calls a special election to be held on November 6, 2001. Such special election shall be coordinated by the Clerk and Recorder for Arapahoe County with the general election of the same date. The purpose of such special election shall be to submit to the registered electors of Cherry Hills Village one or more ballot questions or issues approved by the City Council.


Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby appointed as the Election Official of the Town for the special election. The City Clerk shall have full authority and is hereby directed to perform and discharge all functions and duties imposed upon the City by law.
