

**ORDINANCE NO. 12
Series 2009**

November 19, 2009: Introduced as Council Bill 16, Series 2009 by Councilor Griffin, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Russell Stewart, and considered by the title only on first reading. Passed by a vote of 6 yes and 0 no.

December 8, 2009: Considered in full text on second reading. Passed by a vote of 6 yes and 0 no.

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
ADOPTING A BUDGET AND LEVYING PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE CITY OF CHERRY
HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010**

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village prepared and established a Budget for fiscal year 2010, made such Budget available for public inspection, and held a public hearing prior to adoption of the Budget by the City Council pursuant to Article IX of the Charter of Cherry Hills Village; and

WHEREAS, the Budget provides for expenditures and transfers for all purposes in the amount of \$8,793,587 and

WHEREAS, the Arapahoe County Assessor has certified a taxable assessed valuation for the City of Cherry Hills Village of \$353,167,210; and

WHEREAS, \$2,578,121 of the total expenditures and transfers required shall be derived from ad valorem taxes, and the balance shall be derived from other sources.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, ORDAINS:

Section 1. The City of Cherry Hills Village Budget in the total amount of \$8,793,587 for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2010, and ending December 31, 2010, is hereby approved and adopted.


Section 2. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado, are hereby authorized and directed to certify a General Purpose Levy of fourteen and seven hundred and twenty two thousandths (14.722) mills to the Board of County Commissioners of Arapahoe County, Colorado, on or before the 15th day of December 2009, to be levied against all property within the City of Cherry Hills Village for taxes to be collected in 2010 for the valuation year 2009.

Section 3. The City Council may, by resolution, transfer any unexpended balance in any of the funds to any fund or to a reserve.

Section 4. The City Council, pursuant to Article XX of the Colorado Constitution, supersedes and deems the provision of C.R.S. 1972, 29-1-301, inapplicable.

Section 5. Should any section, clause, sentence or part of this Ordinance be adjudged by any court to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect, impair or invalidate the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.
