

**A RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
REAPPOINTING TERESA HARBAUGH
TO THE PUBLIC ART COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 6-11 established the Public Art Commission; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.1 of the City of Cherry Hills Village City Charter authorizes the City Council to “delegate to board and commissions...such functions, powers and authority of the City as it deems proper and advisable”; and

WHEREAS, Section III of the adopted Art in Public Places Master Plan states the Commission shall consist of up to five (5) members: including one (1) from City Council. On the date of appointment, each member shall be a resident of the City of Cherry Hills Village. Each member shall be a resident of the City throughout his or her term of office; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-8-30 of the City Municipal Code requires each member be appointed by the City Council. The initial term of each member shall be staggered, as outlined in section 8-1 of the City Charter, with subsequent appointments to all be (3) three years. The terms of office shall expire on the third Tuesday of July in each respective year; and

WHEREAS, the term of Commission Teresa Harbaugh is expiring, and which Commissioner Harbaugh has expressed a desire to be reappointed for an additional term; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to reappoint Teresa Harbaugh to a new term on the Public Art Commission.



Introduced, passed and adopted at the regular meeting of City Council this 17th day of July, 2012, by a vote of 5 yes and 0 no.




