

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
ADOPTING THE DENVER REGIONAL
NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN
2010 UPDATE**

WHEREAS, natural hazards in the Denver Region historically have caused significant disasters with losses of life and property and natural resources damage;

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences;

WHEREAS, under the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, an adopted Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs;

WHEREAS, a Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan been prepared in accordance with FEMA requirements at 44 C.F.R. 201.6; and

WHEREAS, The City of Cherry Hills Village has fully participated in the FEMA prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado that:

Section 1. The City of Cherry Hills Village hereby adopts the Denver Regional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan upon approval by the Colorado Office of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

Section 2. The City of Cherry Hills Village will submit this Adoption Resolution to the Colorado Office of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials to enable the Plan's final approval.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.


Introduced, passed and adopted at the
