

**A  
RESOLUTION  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE  
AMENDING THE CITY'S MANAGEMENT PLAN  
FOR RESPONSES TO CONFLICTS WITH COYOTES**

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village has a duty and responsibility to its citizens to protect the public health, safety and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village desires to identify and achieve a balance between the importance of human safety and the native ecology of the region; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village has received significant public comment regarding an increase in coyote-human interactions; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, staff completed a comprehensive Coyote Management Plan modeled from other cities within the metro area and with input from the Colorado Division of Wildlife (CDOW); and

WHEREAS, staff conducted an urban coyote presentation in early 2011 in an effort to provide educational material to the community regarding methods for a safe coexistence with coyotes, during which staff received numerous recommendations to update the current coyote management plan; and


WHEREAS, staff has reviewed and amended the 2009 Coyote Management Plan in an effort to outline a consistent, organized and detailed response process for interaction between the community and coyotes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE:

Section 1. That the 2011 Amended Coyote Management Plan attached hereto is hereby adopted as the official "Coyote Management Plan" for the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.


