

**A RESOLUTION  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE  
CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN MEMBERS  
TO THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION**

**WHEREAS**, Section 8.3 of the City of Cherry Hills Village City Charter requires such members of the Planning and Zoning Commission shall be appointed by the Council for overlapping terms of three years. Each member shall be a taxpaying elector and in addition shall have resided in the area comprising the City at the time of his appointment for at least three years immediately preceding the date of his appointment; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2-6-30 of the Municipal Code indicates the terms of office for members of the Planning and Zoning Commission, which shall be for overlapping three (3) year terms, set to expire the third Tuesday in September of each year; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioners Ira Plotkin and Kevin Iverson each served one complete term, expiring September 15, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Plotkin is eligible and desires to be re-appointed for a second, three-year term; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Iverson indicated his desire not to be re-appointed, therefore leaving a vacancy on the Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, applications to fill the vacancy on the Commission were reviewed by the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to re-appoint Ira Plotkin and appoint Jim Rubin to the Planning and Zoning Commission. Each of these appointments complies with the provision in Section 8.3 of the City Charter and Chapter 2, Article 6 of the Municipal Code.


