WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village has received significant public comment regarding an increase in coyote-human interactions; and


WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village desires to outline a consistent, organized and detailed response process for coyote management related reports.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE:


Section 1. That the strategic plan attached hereto is hereby adopted as the official "Coyote Management Plan" for the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado.
