**A RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF A NEW MEMBER
TO THE CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE ART COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, Section 3.1 of the City of Cherry Hills Village City Charter authorizes the City Council to “delegate to board and commissions...such functions, powers and authority of the City as it deems proper and advisable”; and

WHEREAS, the Cherry Hills Village Art Commission (the “CHVAC”) was established by Resolution 6, Series 2011 and expanded by Resolution 10, Series 2017; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Doug Smooke resigned before the end of his term; and

WHEREAS, applications to serve on the CHVAC were reviewed by Mayor Laura Christman and Councilor Randy Weil; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Christman and Councilor Weil have recommended that the Council appoint Pamela Hall to complete Commissioner Smooke’s term; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to change the end of the term to May to coincide with other board, commission and committee terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE THAT:
