Quincy Farm is a 17.5 acre farm donated to the Village by resident Catherine H. Anderson in 2016. It is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is one of the oldest intact farms in the village, with farmhouses and buildings dating from 1898 and 1934.

4400 E. Quincy Ave.
Cherry Hills Village, CO 80113
(south side of Quincy Avenue at the High Line Canal crossing)

GETTING THERE:

Visitors are encouraged to walk or bike to the Farm if they can – there is access off the High Line Canal trail just south of Quincy Avenue.

PARKING:

Parking will be available at Kent Denver School's dining hall lot at 4000 E. Quincy Ave. The lot is a 0.2 mile walk to the Farm on the High Line Canal. Cars will be permitted into the Farm to drop off visitors; only cars with disability placards will be able to park at the Farm (4400 E. Quincy Avenue).
