2. Describe how this annual progress report (not the credited Plan) was prepared and how it was submitted to the governing body, released to the media, and made available to the public.

The Director of Community Development prepared this report, in coordination with other City staff, based on their collective knowledge of City operations over the last year. This information was provided to our City Council via staff memo in their regular meeting on April 18, 2023, it was released to the media via press release dated April 17, 2023, and it was posted on the Community Development webpage.

○ Project:

Participation and adoption of the Mile High Flood District's (MHFD) master plans affecting the County.

Status:

In progress. CHV continues to work with MHFD identifying capital projects and participates in studies.

- Project
Participation and adoption of the MHFD Flood Hazard Area Delineation (FHAD) studies affecting the County.
Status:
In progress. CHV continues to participate in efforts with the MHFD to identify FHAD areas.
- Project:
Enforcement of floodplain regulations to limit development in the floodplain.
Status:
In progress. CHV continues to enforce our floodplain regulations.
- Project:
Hazards and stormwater mapping.
Status
The timeline for implementation of this project was two to five years from June of 2021.
- Project:
Continued National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) participation.
Status:
In progress. As evidenced by participating in this recertification, CHV remains committed to participating in the NFIP.
- Project:
Bellevue Avenue and Clarkson Street drainage improvements.
Status:
Project is no longer feasible. This project was to support a project in a different jurisdiction. That jurisdiction did not fund their project. Therefore, this project will not move forward at this time.

4. Discuss why any objectives were not reached or why implementation is behind schedule.

The one project that is no longer feasible is a result of an adjacent jurisdiction not funding a project. CHV has no control over what other jurisdictions choose to fund. Without the other project, the CHV project would be meaningless.

CHV will continue to:

- Participate and adopt MHFD master plans affecting Arapahoe County.
- Participate and adopt MHFD FHAD studies affecting Arapahoe County.
- Enforce our floodplain regulations
